



**Prerequisite & GPA Verification Checklist  
Traditional BSN**

Use this form as a tool to accurately prepare your application for the Traditional BSN program. **THIS FORM IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE UPLOADED** but is highly recommended to help you track your preparation for a successful application.

**RULES:**

- All individual course grades must be a minimum of C/2.00 or better.
- Prerequisite GPA of all prerequisite courses, excluding Quantitative Experience (QE), must calculate to 3.00 or higher.
- If you do not have final grades in a prerequisite course at the time of filling out this form, simply leave that information blank. HOWEVER, to be eligible for application, you must be able to provide transcripts/grades for all courses indicated on the form by May 1, 2024.
- If you satisfied any prerequisite course with a test score (AP/IB/SAT/ACT/CLEP), please indicate this on the form by writing AP/IB/SAT/ACT/CLEP in the grade earned field.
- Pass/No Pass (P/N), Credit/No Credit (C/NC) and Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) grades are not permitted.
- All courses must have grades from within the last 10 years. For the 2024 cohort, courses taken prior to June 2017 will not be accepted. ENG 1020, PSY 1010/1020, and QE requirements will not expire.
- Only one prerequisite course may be repeated within a 7-year period; original courses with a grade of C/2.00 or higher that were repeated for a better grade will not count as a repeat.
- Official transcripts and test scores must be submitted to WSU for verification. Directions on how to submit official transcripts are found at the end of this form.
- A single grade must be entered to calculate your GPA. If the course was a split course (example: one course for the lecture (3 credits)/one course for the lab (1 credit), for a total of 4 credits), please [utilize this GPA calculator to create a single GPA-equivalent grade for the course](#).
- All grades must be entered in their equivalent GPA form. Please use the following chart to provide the GPA equivalent for letter grades:

## Calculate Your GPA

The credit value for each course is standardized for equity. If your class was more (or less) credits, it will still be calculated at the value indicated.

- 1) Calculate the honor points for EACH completed class:

$$\text{Honor Points} = \text{Grade (0.00-4.00)} \times \text{Credits}$$

- 2) Add all Honor Point values to create a single total:

$$\begin{aligned} & (\text{BIO 1510/11 Honor Points}) + (\text{BIO 2870 Honor Points}) \\ & + (\text{CHM 1020 Honor Points}) \dots \text{and so on} \dots \end{aligned}$$

- 3) Add the total number of credits for all classes calculated in honor points:

$$\text{BIO 1510/11 (3)} + \text{BIO 2870 (5)} + \text{CHM 1020 (5)} \dots \text{and so on} \dots$$

- 4) Divide total honor points by total credits:

$$\text{Prerequisite GPA} = \text{Total Honor Points} / \text{Total Credits}$$
