<b>Information</b> For the MSN to PhD curriculum, 3 credits of an advanced methods course and 9 credits of concentration courses are required to complete degree requirements. For the BSN to PhD curriculum, 3 credits of an advanced methods course and 15 credits of concentration courses are required. In both curriculums, 9 credits must be taken outside of the College of Nursing. A concentration course is a class in a discipline or subject related to nursing but may be offered by another department or College. Concentration courses are intended to support coursework and allow the student to develop a focused specialty. The Concentration Plan Form must be completed and signed by the student's advisor and the Director of the PhD Program prior to taking a concentration course. This form is intended to outline the concentration courses and justify their relevance to the student's plan of work. <b>Instructions: Please list your planned concentration electives below, including the semester that you are hoping to take the course. Provide a brief description of the relevance of each course to your dissertation topic and plan of work. If you decide to make a change, you must submit an updated form.</b>
