Instructions

The written portion of the qualifying examination is required of PhD students. It provides the student to demonstrate that their written work is of sufficient depth and breadth, encompasses the substantive knowledge. Further, that the student can demonstrate the ability of integration of concepts and synthesis of literature.

The written portion consists of three (3) written papers that have demonstrated the outlined criteria.

The final Qualifying Exam grade for the written portion will be determined by a majority vote of the Qualifying Exam Committee members. The student must pass all three papers.

Qualifying Exam Committee chair will complete the “Qualifying Examination: Approval of Written Component” and all committee members will sign the form. This form will be turned in to Doctoral Program Director.

Student will be notified, by the committee chair, of their grade within 24 hours of the committee vote. This may be done through Email. If the written portion is passed, then, the oral examination is scheduled to take place within the following two weeks. It is suggested that this date is tentatively planned in advance to expedite the meeting process **For complete instructions on the Qualifying Exam see your PhD student handbook.**
